

## **Wolfe-Renninger Memorial Education Grant Application (Filing Procedures & Guidelines)**

1. Grants are available to NCUL member credit unions for training and development to improve the functioning and performance of the sponsoring credit union.
2. Grant money will normally be limited to programs conducted, sponsored and/or endorsed by the NCUL, and typically conducted within the state of Nebraska. The determination of eligible programs will be at the sole discretion of the NCUL Education Committee in consultation with NCUL staff.
3. Application for a grant requires completing a request form and attaching the past two years of Year-End Financials and budgets allocated for training. Also a short explanation as to why the credit union is seeking financial assistance will be included with each application. Incomplete applications or applications without the attachments will not be processed.
4. Grant applications must be received **at least 20 days prior to the event.** The Education Committee will then respond within 10 days of event. Deadlines are subject to alteration if event notification or registration is shortened.
5. There will be no limitation on the number of grants awarded to any credit union per calendar year; however, the total of financial assistance to any credit union will normally not exceed \$1,000 for that year. The Education Committee will exercise judgement in the extent of grant money provided to any one credit union to assure that money is appropriately distributed among Nebraska credit unions with financial need and a desire to participate in programs for which grants are available.
